Thirty years ago a community on the outskirts of Leon turned a local bus station into a school. For decades the land owner didn't need the station.

This year he explained to the school that he now needs his land back; a situation that will leave this community and 85 of their kids, without a place to learn.

Due to their lack of resources , the Ministry of Education approached SchoolBOX to help build a new 4 classroom school that will include these 85 students and meet the needs of an overflowing urban school comprised of 200 students.



SchoolBOX lobbied the local government to build 2 classrooms and we are urgently asking supporters to help us fund the remaining 2 classrooms. The local government has donated land for the school and pledged machinery and man hours to help level and prepare this land. Parents are also waiting to volunteer their time to build their children's school.

This project is another example of the collaboration between SchoolBOX, the Ministry of Education, local government and the community to 'Make Education Possible' . We would be so grateful to have your support.
