The preschool at the La Sabana School was built with mud, bricks, wood and corrugated metal by the parents of the community over 30 years ago. Over the years, the structure has been exposed to the elements and is currently in state of decay. The crumbling structure is a hazard for the students and teachers, especially during earthquakes.

The parents anticipate an increase in the number of children attending school in the next year, as there are many young children in the surrounding areas. This thriving community desperately wants a safe and secure location for their children to learn.
